Patient reported outcomes in clinical practice for the head and neck multiprofessional team: time to make this the reality

There are various examples of the use of Patient Reported Outcomes (PRO) in clinical practice. It is an opportune moment for reflection and to help make the salient points which we can draw upon:

- i. the completion of the National Institute for Health Research (RfPB) funded cluster preference randomised controlled trial 'Improving quality of life through the routine use of the patient concerns inventory (PCI) for head and neck cancer patients'
- ii. the inclusion of the PCI to provide an enhanced electronic Holistic Needs Assessment module (eHNA)
- iii. the imminent rollout of the NHS England QOL Metric to all cancers in October 2021. What lessons can we learn and what are the potential impacts on patient care?
